

Golf courses operated by the City of St. Petersburg are **OPEN** to the public.

Effective Monday, October 31, for the health and safety of patrons and staff, the golf courses have implemented the following procedures to help reduce the spread of COVID-19:

- Patrons and employees are **required** to wear face coverings while in the Pro Shop per Pinellas County ordinance. Patrons seated at a table may remove their face coverings to eat or drink.
- Carts with a seat divider are available at no additional cost (limited supply). Riders may pay an additional fee for single rider golf carts: \$8.00 at Mangrove Bay Golf Course and \$3.00 at Twin Brooks and Cypress Links Golf Courses. Golf carts will be washed and sanitized after each use.
- Plexiglass shields have been installed at Point of Sale terminals.
- Routine cleaning of clubhouse is being performed throughout each day.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet is encouraged in all areas on the golf course.
